Dear Mill Hill Residents

As we write this not only Christmas but also Easter have come and gone – it seems hard to believe and the nights are definitely cooling down and the leaves turning... We at Mill Hill Residents Association (MHRA) do everything we can to ensure that our suburb is well maintained and secure and so ask that you support us in our endeavours through both your financial support and keeping in touch.

SECURITY

Security is our major function and expense but as we continue to work closely with Randburg SAPS as part of the Sector 5 Community Police Forum, we are constantly reminded of how critical it is that we maintain and strengthen our security – **CRIME IS VERY CLOSE and CRIME IS SADLY ON THE INCREASE.** There have been recent incidents in almost all the areas adjacent to us! We cannot be complacent and so remind you that your security starts in your own home and that living in a boomed suburb does not make you/us immune to crime. ALWAYS active your alarm system when you are not at home and even if you just 'pop out'! Close and lock all doors and windows in rooms you are not using and make use of security gates if you like to keep them open and to separate the sleeping area from the rest of the house at night (if possible). The crime stats show us that many crimes take place during the day and 12h00 to 16h00 is not uncommon for house robbery/burglary.
